Skanska Announces New Regional Design Manager

NASHVILLE, Tenn., Oct. 13, 2008 – Skanska USA Building Inc. announced today the addition of Edward Belbusti as Regional Design Manager for the company's Southeast operations. Based out of Skanska's Nashville, Tennessee office, Belbusti will oversee architecture and design operations for the company's projects in Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Ohio, Tennessee and Texas.
