**Skanska to Build Student Activity Center
At Clayton State University**

Skanska USA Building Inc. announced that it will provide pre-construction and construction management services for a new Student Activity Center at Clayton State University in Morrow, Ga. Cooper Carry & Associates is the architect of record for this \$13.3 million facility.

The 61,000-square-foot building will serve as a recreational area and an activity hub for students. It will include a ballroom that can be subdivided for small functions, a pre-function area, a warming kitchen, game rooms, a café, a fitness assessment office, student government offices with support spaces, a gymnasium, locker rooms, several multipurpose rooms and associated storage and ancillary spaces.

“We are very excited to work with the University System of Georgia’s Board of Regents and Clayton State to build this facility,” said Steve Laux, Skanska Area General Manager. “Our professionals plan to deliver a building that provides the highest-quality space and accommodations.”

Groundbreaking is planned for later this summer; the Student Activity Center is expected to open in the fall of 2008.
