San Antonio Awarded \$34 Million Project from Texas A&M University

College Station, T.X. – Skanska USA today announced that its building business unit, a leading provider of construction management, preconstruction and design-build services, has been awarded a contract to construct the Arts and Humanities Building at Texas A&M University in College Station, Texas.

“We are thrilled to work with Texas A&M to construct a new facility that supports innovative instruction and promotes interdisciplinary collaboration within the arts and humanities on-campus departments,” said Brian Freeman, Skanska Executive Vice President. “Our goal is to construct a building that will facilitate creative work among all scholars and students of music, theater, performance, literature and related fields.”

The project recently broke ground with completion scheduled for summer of 2012.
