### Skanska wins another industry leading award

Skanska Rashleigh Weatherfoil (SRW), Skanska's mechanical and electrical arm, has picked up an award for driving down energy consumption, costs and carbon emissions.

SRW, was recognised for the green retrofit of Hollywood House, their own office in Woking, Surrey, in the 'Time-proven mechanical and electrical installation' category at the Heating & Ventilation News awards.

The work at Hollywood House has seen carbon emissions, energy consumption and water use significantly reduced while providing a comfortable, energy efficient environment for the Skanska team based there.
