## Skanska provides preconstruction services and site demolition in New York City for \$34 million

Skanska has signed a contract with the New York City Economic Development Corporation (NYCEDC) for preconstruction services and site demolition related to the New York City Public Health Lab in New York City. The contract is worth \$34 million which will be included in the US order bookings for the first quarter of 2020.

Skanska will provide design and constructability reviews, estimating and the demolition of three buildings at the Harlem Hospital complex.

Demolition began in February 2020 and is scheduled for completion in July 2021.
