Skanska Wins Federal Law Enforcement Training Center Project

Skanska USA Building Inc. announces that it will build a new dormitory at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC) residential training site in Artesia, N.M. The architect is Greenville, S.C.-based Enwright Associates, Inc.

The \$31.5 million facility, built to add capacity at the site, will have 448 rooms and accommodate up to 896 people. Amenities include private baths, cable television and telephones. Construction is expected to begin in June 2006. In addition to the dormitory, Skanska is constructing a Physical Techniques and Aquatics facility on the Artesia campus.

Overseen by the Department of Homeland Security, the FLETC trains law enforcement agents for 81 Federal agencies and also serves state, local, and international law enforcement agencies. The Artesia location in southeastern New Mexico has a full range of facilities for conducting basic and advanced law enforcement training, including anti-terrorism programs. This campus is being expanded to support the Center's increased role in training Border Patrol and Immigration agents and patrol officers.

"We at Skanska are certainly proud to have earned this new Federal project," said Paul Anderson, Chief Operating Officer of Skanska USA Building's Atlanta office. "Our country should always have superior facilities to train its law enforcement officers, and this building for FLETC will embody such excellence."
