Skanska USA Selected to Complete Cooper City High School Project

Dania Beach, Fla. – Skanska USA announced today that its building business unit, which is a leading provider of construction management, preconstruction, and design-build services, has been awarded a contract to complete a 121,407-square-foot project of new and renovated facilities for Cooper City High School in Cooper City.

The project includes construction of a new 115,082 three-story administration/classroom building with 3,225 square feet of related spaces, remodeling of an existing building into a new 3,100-square-foot child care services building, selected demolition, and MEP and site work improvements to upgrade school amenities, student safety and student flow.

“We are honored to be selected for another school project in Broward County and excited to be working with architect Song + Associates once again,” said Russ Sheppard, Skanska senior vice president.
