Skanska to Provide Design Build Services for new Research Laboratory

San Antonio, Texas – Skanska USA Building Inc. announced today it has been named design build manager for a research laboratory in Texas.

Skanska will include \$61.1 million in its first-quarter order bookings for the project. Skanska's share of the project is 75 percent.

Jacobs is the design partner and will be providing the design for the 181,200 square foot laboratory which will include various lab spaces.

The construction phase will begin in August 2009 with a March 2011 expected completion date.
