Skanska Lands Higher Education Project for the University of Connecticut

New Haven, C.T. – Skanska has secured a \$41.3 million contract to provide preconstruction and constructions services for a new 132,000 square-foot building for a high-education client in Storrs, Connecticut.

The new four-story educational facility, which includes classroom and lecture hall spaces, will house the five social sciences and humanities departments while bringing improved classroom facilities into the heart of the campus. The new building will complement the existing architecture and is expected to meet the requirements of a LEED® Silver rating, as established by the U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC).

Pedestrian and vehicular access, security and safety are of prime concerns during the construction phase of the project. Because the building is located in the heart of the campus, Skanska will conduct significant logistical site planning, oversight and maintenance necessary to minimize the construction project's impact on operations.

Work is scheduled to be completed for occupancy by July 2012.

The work will be carried out by Skanska USA Building's office in New Haven, Connecticut.
