Skanska Hired to Manage and Build Wilmington Hospital Campus Expansion in Delaware

Philadelphia, PA – Skanska USA Building Inc. announced today that its Philadelphia-metro office has been retained by Christiana Care Health System to provide construction management services and to build a \$178 million, 386,000-square-foot campus expansion to the Wilmington Hospital in Wilmington, Delaware. This hospital expansion will be Skanska's fifth major project with the Christiana Care Health System.

Designed by Wilmot/Sanz, Inc., the new facility will span nine stories and include a new vertical patient tower expansion, medical office building, and emergency department and operating room renovations and expansions. A new, two-story main entrance with an ambulance bay below will also be constructed as well as two new floors for the emergency department while the area is in full operation. Prior to the start of construction, all major utilities will be relocated and replaced.

Skanska's Lyle Frederick will be the lead Project Executive on the expansion, which is expected to be completed in in summer 2013. Frederick brings more than 30 years of industry experience to the expansion, including work for Skanska on three other Christiana Care Health System projects and nine medical facility assignments overall.

"With our successful history with long-term client Christiana Care Health System, we're looking forward to expanding Wilmington Hospital to help it provide even more advanced medical services to the local community," said Edward Szwarc, Skanska's Area General Manager for the Philadelphia-metro office. "In addition, Lyle and Skanska have significant experience expanding and upgrading hospitals while they remain in full operation, so we expect this project to be completed on time, all while the Wilmington Hospital continues to treat patients."

Skanska will include the full value of this project in its first quarter 2009 bookings.
