## **Skanska USA Announces Project Win for QIAGEN Campus in Maryland**

*Selected to complete \$39 million multi-building expansion*

Rockville, M.D. – Skanska USA announced today that its building business unit, which is a leading provider of construction management, preconstruction, and design-build services, has been awarded a contract to complete a 117,500-square-foot expansion of global biotechnology leader QIAGEN's campus in Germantown, Maryland.

The multi-building expansion will include a manufacturing addition used for mechanical and utilities space, a two-level parking garage with 515 available parking spaces, a cafeteria expansion that will boast a new loading dock, and a new five-story office administrative building.

"Skanska has a proven track record in building state-of-the-art facilities for the world's leading biotech and healthcare companies," said Chuck Brawley, General Manager and Executive Vice President at Skanska USA. "Health and wellness is extremely important to us, and we hope to continue to expand our work in healthcare construction in the greater D.C. area to build more top-notch medical and research facilities like this one."

Upon completion, the expansion, which will enable the company to consolidate several key manufacturing operations, is expected to accommodate 90 new jobs for QIAGEN.

The expansion will be built in four phases, and is expected to be completed in March 2012.
