Skanska Celebrates Significant Milestone at MidMichigan Medical Center

Portage, Mich. – Skanska USA Building Inc. announced today that it hosted a "topping out" ceremony marking the last piece of steel placed atop MidMichigan Medical Center's Harlow building on Wednesday, March 18 in Midland, Michigan.

Nearly 100 hospital workers and community members attended the event to watch the final steel beam be placed on top of the five-story building. The beam was decorated with signatures from hospital workers, a live memorial evergreen tree, the American flag and the Iron Workers Local 25 flag.

"This ceremony signifies the hard work and dedication going into the expansion and renovation of MidMichigan Medical Center's largest investment project," said Skanska's Kirk Frownfelter, Executive Vice President, "Skanska is proud to provide a first-class facility for this campus, the flagship of the MidMichigan Health System."

The three-phase, 270,000-square-foot Harlow Building expansion project, includes additions and renovations to the post anesthetic care unit and the ambulatory surgery departments. Six new operating rooms will be constructed, along with the renovation of 10 existing operating rooms, including two that will be used exclusively for heart procedures.

The project will also give the hospital a new main entrance, first floor retail and support function space, and reconfigured campus drives and parking lots.

Skanska is providing pre-construction and construction management services for the Harlow Building expansion project. The project is slated for compeletion in 2012.
