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Skanska Selected as Construction Manager for Mohegan Sun Project Horizon

Skanska USA Building Inc. announced it has been selected by the Mohegan Tribal Gaming Authority as construction manager for the Northern Expansion portion of Mohegan Sun's \$740 million Project Horizon expansion in Uncasville, Conn. Wimberly Allison Tong & Goo (WATG) of Irvine, Calif. will serve as the Architect of Record for the project.

Skanska will include \$350 million in its second quarter order bookings for the project. Skanska's share of the project is 100 percent.

The project will include a 1,000-room hotel tower expansion, 115,000 square feet of additional retail and dining space, a 40,000-square-foot office building and a 3,600-space parking garage.

Mohegan Sun's new 1,000-room hotel is expected to feature a unique House of Blues experience including 300 House of Blues-themed hotel rooms, which will be owned and operated by Mohegan Sun, and an exclusive, members-only House of Blues Foundation Room[™] to be located on the upper floors of the new hotel. House of Blues is a Live Nation Brand.

Construction of the project will begin in September of this year with an estimated completion date in 2010.

Skanska is currently constructing a 400-room hotel and casino addition to Greektown Casino in Detroit, Michigan and the 185,000-square-foot Casino Snoqualmie in Snoqualmie, Washington.
