During the next period we will be carrying out the following operations:-

- Dismantling of scaffolding to the rear of 81 89,
- Final structural investigations,
- Demolition/deconstruction of rear low level elements of buildings 81 – 89 Knightsbridge to the site entrance and processing area,
- Construction of both of our tower crane bases,
- Erection of Tower Crane 1,
- Demolition/deconstruction of 2 William Street to form site entrance,
- Demolition/deconstruction of rear low level elements of buildings 57 65 Knightsbridge Road,
- Underpinning of the foundations to rear of 4 William Street,
- Erection of Masons scaffold to the Knightsbridge elevation.
