Skanska Selected as Construction Manager for Springstead High School

Skanska USA Building Inc. announced it has been awarded the construction contract by the School Board of Hernando County for the 49,000-square-foot additions and renovations to Springstead High School in Springhill, Fla. Gould Evans Associates is the architect on the \$12 million project, which is scheduled to be completed in October, 2008.

Project scope includes a new 24,000-square-foot cafeteria and kitchen and a 7,000-square-foot addition for a new fine arts facility. Renovations of 18,000 square feet from the existing cafeteria and classroom building will be converted into new science classrooms, laboratories and administrative offices.

To meet new district standards, upgrades will be made to the data wiring along with modifications of the HVAC system, fire alarm and intercom system. Also included in the contract is a new fire sprinkler system throughout the school and new parking and circulation improvements.
