Skanska to Construct Hospital for a Repeat Client in North Carolina

Skanska has secured the assignment to construct a new hospital campus in North Carolina for a confidential client. The contract amounts to \$141.5 million, which will be included in order bookings for the first quarter of 2011. This will be the third project Skanska has completed for this client.

The new campus consists of a 241,574-square-foot patient tower and diagnostic and treatment building, a 60,000-square-foot physician's office building, a central energy plant and associated site work.

The project is planned to achieve LEED® Certification.

Work will begin in late April and is scheduled for completion in July 2015.
