Skanska Named General Contractor for New Kalamazoo/Battle Creek International Airport Air Traffic Control Tower

Kalamazoo, M.I. – Skanska USA announced today that its building business unit, which is a leading provider of construction management, preconstruction and design-build services, has been selected as general contractor for the new air traffic control tower at the Kalamazoo/Battle Creek International Airport.

Atlanta, Ga.-based architecture firm Hartrampf will provide design services for the 167-foot tower and the associated 20,100-square-foot Terminal Radar Approach Control (TRACON) center. The construction phase began in September 2010, with an expected completion in the first quarter of 2012. At that time, the FAA will begin installation of all air traffic equipment, which is expected to take an additional 18 months. The cost of the project is \$12.1 million.

Skanska USA has regional offices in Kalamazoo and Southfield, and has overseen numerous construction and design projects in Michigan, including the terminal addition under way at Kalamazoo/Battle Creek International Airport.

Other projects in the region include: Baraga County Memorial Hospital in L'Anse, Battle Creek Central High School in Battle Creek, MidMichigan Health Systems Harlow Surgery expansion in Harlow, the Holland Community Hospital renovation and expansion in Holland, and multiple projects at Kellogg Community College in Battle Creek.
