Skanska expands and renovates University of Virginia hospital in Virginia, USA for USD 142M

Charlottesville, VA. (December 1, 2016) – Skanska announced that it has signed a contract with existing client the University of Virginia to renovate and expand its hospital. The contract is a multi-phased Construction Management at Risk with design phase services contract. Skanska USA Building will include the full value of USD 142M, in its fourth quarter order bookings.

The project is a 444,000-SF, 15-level expansion as well as 90,000-SF of renovation work.

Construction services began in June of 2015. The entire hospital expansion and renovation project is slated for completion in December 2020.
