### New reporting structure in financial reports

Skanska will launch a new reporting structure in the financial reports starting with the Three month report 2017.

The Construction stream will be divided into the geographies the Nordics (of which Sweden), Europe and USA. The Residential Development stream will be divided into the geographies the Nordics (of which Sweden) and Europe. The Commercial Property Development and Infrastructure Development streams will be left unchanged.

The change has the intention to reduce complexity and in a more balanced way reflect the impact on the Group's performance within and between Skanska's business streams.
