Bank of America Tower is the most sustainable office tower in Houston. The tower is the first LEED v4 Platinum Core & Shell certified project in the United States. At 780,000 square feet, Bank of America Tower has also been recognized as the largest LEED v4 Platinum Core & Shell project in the world to date.

SKYPARK

The 24,000-square-foot SkyPark is the first and largest green roof in Downtown Houston to be open to all building tenants. It offers wellness and social activities while also reducing the urban heat island effect in downtown.




This evergreen ground cover grows to around 6" tall and can reach 5' in length.

One of the best and toughest ground cover plants for arid regions, rosemary also helps minimize weeds.




The strap-leaf foliage never grows beyond its designated size, which is perfect for urban gardens.

Considered one of the most beautiful native grasses, they also provide drought tolerance to modern landscapes.


