Skanska Selected to Build Police Training Facility for City of Orlando

ORLANDO, Fla., Aug. 11, 2008 – Skanska USA Building Inc. announced today it has been selected for design-build services for the city of Orlando's new \$15 million, 70,000-square-foot Police Training Facility. Located at 100 Andes Avenue, the new facility will be used for training and certifying the use of firearms required for officers in the line of duty. The architect of record is C.T. Hsu & Associates and completion is expected in March 2009.

"Many of our projects make a difference in our Orlando community, but we are extremely proud to work on a facility that will help support the officers that keep Orlando safe," said Randy Bernard, Skanska's Senior Vice President for Orlando. "It is an honor to be able to support our city with this type of project."

The building will include many specialized features designed to meet the requirements of officer training. The firearms training area will include three ranges in an enclosed environment. A weapons cleaning room that will accommodate up to 80 work stations is included, as is a secure, fireproofed ammunition vault.

Additionally, the new facility will feature a three-classroom education area that can hold 120 trainees and will include Internet connectivity by means of a fiber optic connection. Support spaces – such as administrative offices, locker rooms and more – are also being built. Skanska will also make site improvements including parking facilities, lighting, underground utilities, controlled access, perimeter fencing and landscaping.

The project is part of Skanska's Small/Special Projects group in Orlando that was announced in September, 2007.
